12.	Evidence of Employment status For employees: Letter from employer showing date of employment, salary, title, and granting holidays. For entrepreneurs: Copy of the company commercial registration (in English). Company's bank statements for the last three months. For Independent Professional: Copy of the professional card issued by the union. Certificate of practicing the profession. For Housewives: Proof of the professional situation of the spouse. Proof of sufficient financial funds of the spouse as indicated above. For Retired: Statement of the social security department proofing salary of retirement. For Students: Registration from the school / university. Proof of holidays from the school / university. Proof of financial funds of the head of the family as indicated above.	
13.	For minors: Travel authorization from both parents certified by the police station. English birth certificate of the child showing full name of both parents. Guardianship decisions along with translation if there is any. Proof of financial funds of the head of the family. 	
14.	Embassy's visa fee (54 JOD).	

- On this checklist, all submitted documents supporting the visa application were ticked.

- The applicant is requested to provide as much information as possible to document his/her family background, professional and socio-economic status, ownership of land or real estate. This information is **essential** to correctly judge the intention of the applicant to leave the Schengen area before the expiry of his/her visa.
- o In some cases, the Consulate may require extra documents from the applicant.
- Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicant.
